

Foldable - The Paleolithic Age (Old Stone Age)

- Step 1: Hold the paper portrait style. Measure in about 1" from the right side of the paper. Draw a line from the top to the bottom. Fold the left edge of the paper to the line you drew. For a title, write "The Paleolithic Age (Old Stone Age)".
- Step 2: Create four boxes by folding the paper in half from the top to the bottom and then in half again. Open the paper and cut on the folds to make the flaps. Do not cut all the way across. Label the four boxes on the front of the foldable as follows:

Obtaining Food
Work of Men and Woman
Adaptation
Arts and Crafts

- Step 3: Open the foldable. Use your notes (from textbook pp. 44-49, the Prezi Presentation, The Paleolithic PowerPoint, and The Paleolithic video) to write a summary for each heading on the left side of each flap. Include important information and examples for each summary. Draw at least two pictures for each summary on the right side of the flap. Color and label the pictures. Pictures should be two different examples.

Include the following in your summaries:

Obtaining Food

How did they get their food? What tools did they use?
What food did they get?

Work of Men and Women

What jobs did they do? In addition to hunting and gathering, what other jobs did they do?

Adaptation

Include at least four ways humans adapted to their environment.

Arts and Crafts

What did they create? How did they create it? What materials did they use?
